THE EASTER SEASON

We often think of Easter as a day, but Easter is a season lasting fifty days. It is “a week of Sundays”; seven Sundays and then Pentecost Sunday, which concludes the Easter Season.

The first eight days, or Octave of Easter, are solemn feast days in which we pray the Gloria and recite the Nicene Creed as we do for most Sundays of the year. The Gospel readings during the Octave are about the appearances of the risen Jesus to the disciples.

For the rest of Easter, we are given the teachings of Jesus found in the Gospels. Now we hear them as coming from the risen Lord rather than the earthly Jesus. We are like the disciples in that we need to reconsider the teachings of Jesus in light of the resurrection.

Most of the other readings for the masses of the Easter Season come from the Acts of the Apostles. What happened to Jesus before His ascension happens to His followers: teaching, miracles, calling new followers, trials, suffering, and death. As goes Jesus, so goes the Church. Jesus conquers His enemies. The Church is triumphant over its enemies. The Church continues the mission begun by Jesus Christ.

The Easter Season concludes on Pentecost Sunday. (June 9th this year) Pentecost commemorates the sending forth of the Church to continue the mission of Jesus Christ to draw all people to God. What began in the Upper Room with the coming of the Holy Spirit is still going on today. Jesus Christ acts through the Church, His body, to bring salvation to the world.

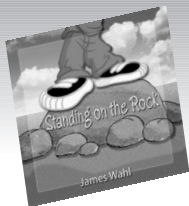
