WHAT IS A EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS?

The word “congress” comes from the French word meaning a meeting or gathering. Most Americans would refer to the event as a conference. A eucharistic congress is a public gathering dedicated to deepening our understanding of the sacrament of the Eucharist and displaying our devotion to Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

Unlike a legislative congress, everyone is invited to attend this gathering. There are no representatives, only participants. There is no cost to enter the building where the conference is held. You do not have to be Catholic to attend. The only qualification is your willingness to attend.

During the congress, there will be speeches, educational presentations, prayer services, informational exhibits, religious article sales, and other activities going on simultaneously for different age groups and interests. Most of these will be bi-lingual. A person can attend some or all of the events and stay at the congress for as little or as long as they desire.

Our Parish has chartered a bus to attend the congress. Watch for sign-up sheets in the foyers to reserve your seat. We are asking for a \$10 per person donation to help defer the costs.

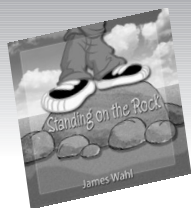
