WHY IS THE DIOCESE OF BIRMINGHAM HAVING A EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS?

June 29, 2019 will mark the 50th anniversary of the establishment of our diocese! The Diocese of Birmingham in Alabama was officially established on June 29, 1969. (June 29th is the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. St. Paul is the patron saint of our diocese.) It was split from the former Diocese of Mobile-Birmingham. Its original Ordinary was Most Rev. Joseph G. Vath, D.D.

The parish of St. Paul's in Birmingham was established in 1892 and later became the co-cathedral of Diocese of Mobile-Birmingham. St. Paul is the patron of missionaries and, along with Peter, is one of the "Missionary Apostles". The state of Alabama, like most of the Southeast United States, is considered mission territory by the Catholic Church because of its small Catholic population-roughly 4% of the total population of the state.

Having a eucharistic congress is a way of acknowledging the Catholic Faith that has been nurtured by the Lord through so many people over the past 50 years. Is it also a way to give thanks to God for the perseverance in the faith of the people of the Diocese of Birmingham.

Our Parish has chartered a bus to attend the congress. The sign-up sheets are in the foyers to reserve your seat. We are asking for a \$10 per person donation to help defer the costs.

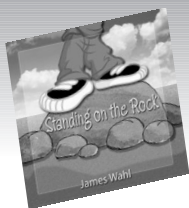
