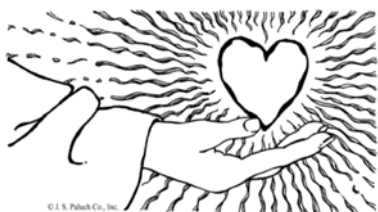

The presentations and displays will be located in the convention area on the East side of the complex. That is because a congress is like a convention. There will be presentations going on simultaneously, so they will be held in different rooms in the complex.

Our Lady of the Lake is arranging transportation from the parish on both Friday and Saturday. We have reserved a 56-passenger bus for transportation to and from Birmingham each day. The cost is \$10 per person, per day. There is a sign-up sheet with details in each vestibule of the church. If we fail to come close to filling up a bus, other arrangements will be made.

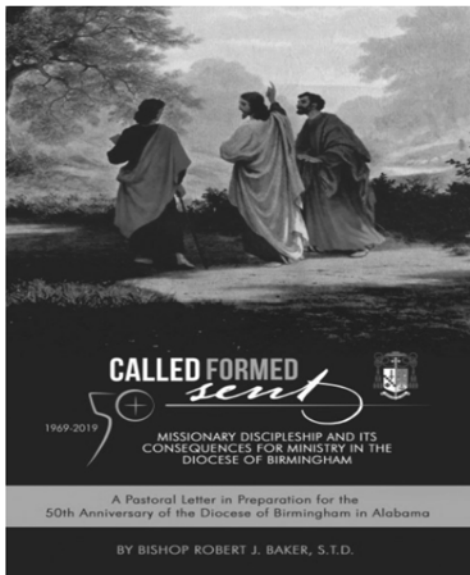
