THE CLOSING MASS OF THE EUCCHARISTIC CONGRESS

At the end of the Eucharistic Congress, Bishop Baker will celebrate Mass with all of those present. This will include visiting bishops, priests, deacons, and laity. The Mass is scheduled to begin at 4:00pm on Saturday, June 29th. The readings and prayers will be for the 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time. This mass will fulfill the Sunday obligation for all who attend.

Bishop Baker has decreed that all Saturday anticipated masses in the Diocese be cancelled that day. There will be no Saturday 5:00p.m. Mass at Our Lady of the Lake parish on June 29th.

You may attend the closing mass of the Eucharistic Congress in Birmingham. You may attend any of the Sunday morning masses at Our Lady of the Lake on Sunday, June 30th. If you are unable to attend any of these masses or mass at another parish, you are excused from mass attendance that weekend. It is still important to spend time worshipping God, even if you are unable to attend mass. In that case, dedicate some time to God through prayer that Sunday.

Our Lady of the Lake is arranging transportation from the parish on both Friday and Saturday. We have reserved a 56-passenger bus for transportation to and from Birmingham each day. The cost is \$10 per person, per day. There is a sign-up sheet with details in each vestibule of the church. If we fail to come close to filling up a bus, other arrangements will be made.

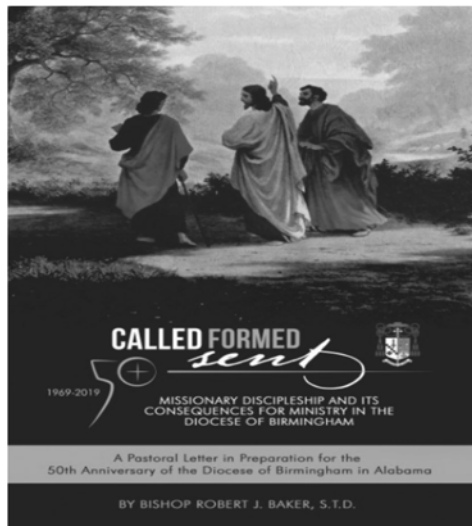

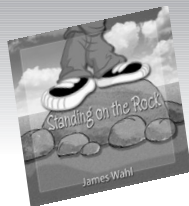
