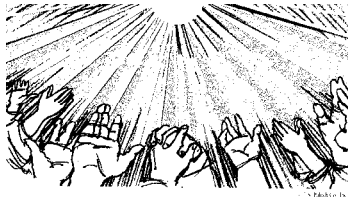

WHAT IS A VOCATION?

The word, "Vocation" comes from the Latin word, "Vocare" or "Calling." A vocation is the life God calls us to live. It is not what we do. It who we are in relationship to Jesus Christ.

To serve the Church, Jesus Christ calls men and women to religious vocations as priests, consecrated religious, and deacons. There are also laypeople who Christ calls to serve His Church. In the sacrament of Matrimony, Christ calls men and women to serve the Church in their families.

First of all, a person discovers their vocation, their calling from Christ, by being aware that they **have** a vocation. They must ask the question, "Lord Jesus, what plans do you have for me?". A person begins by asking that question for one day: "Lord Jesus, what plans do you have for me today?" It begins by caring about what God wants as much as we care about what we want. Eventually, we care **more** about what God wants than we do about what we want. This is when our vocation becomes clearer.

Bishop Baker has written a prayer for vocations to the priesthood to be prayed in our diocese. Copies of the prayer in English and Spanish can be found in the foyers of the church. Fr. Bill

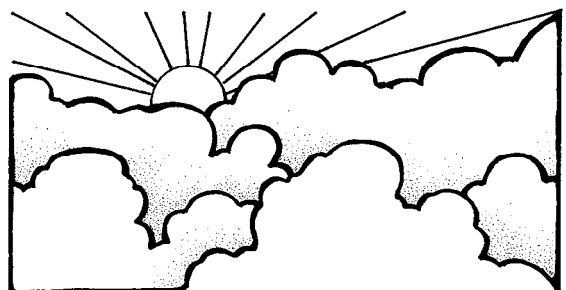

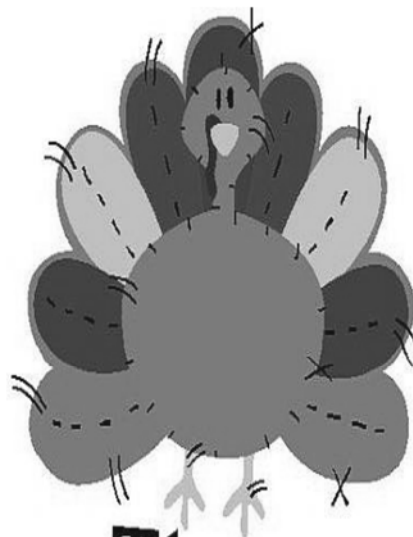

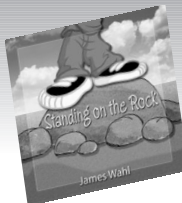
