THE LAST THINGS

November is the month of All Souls. It is a time to remember those who have died and to pray for them. It is important to remember that we still have a relationship with those who have died. Death changes our relationship with them, but it does not end the relationship. Because we all belong to Christ, we belong to each other.

What Happens When We Die?

According to the Bible, when we die our soul is separated from our body. The soul goes to eternity while the body remains in this world. At the Final Judgement our souls will be reunited with a spiritual body, what St. Paul calls a glorified body. (1 Corinthians 15, 42-44)

In the Profession of Faith, we say that we believe in, "the resurrection of the body and life everlasting." As human beings made by God, our body and soul go together. But because of sin our body has to be remade after the pattern of Jesus Christ's resurrection. (1 Corinthians 15, 20-23) Jesus Christ died and was raised from the dead. We will be, too.

Why Do We Pray For The Dead?

Those who we pray for at Mass or at other times of prayer are those who are in the state of Purgatory. What the Church teaches about Purgatory: All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of Heaven.

They are being purified of their attachment to sin, which disorders our relationships to our neighbors. Jesus teaches that the two great commandments are to love God with our heart, mind and strength and to love our neighbor as ourselves. If we fail to love God, we go to Confession and receive absolution to restore our relationship to God. If we fail to love our neighbor, in addition to confession, we need to do acts of penance to change the way we treat others. (Ephesians 4, 22-24)

We can assist those in Purgatory. We can help them by our prayers. We pray that God by His grace will change their heart and minds so that they will lose their attachment to sin and grow in love. We pray for them in the same way that we would pray for someone on earth. Through Jesus Christ, we have a relationship with the souls in Purgatory just as we have a relationship with those on earth.

If you receive the Body of Christ only, you receive all the Eucharistic Lord. He is not divided between the host and the chalice. You do not lose grace by receiving communion under one species.

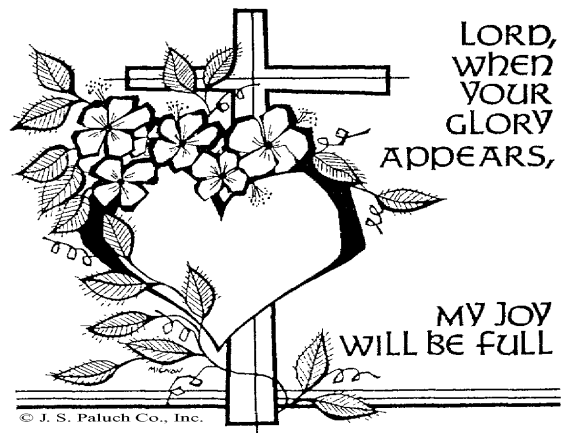

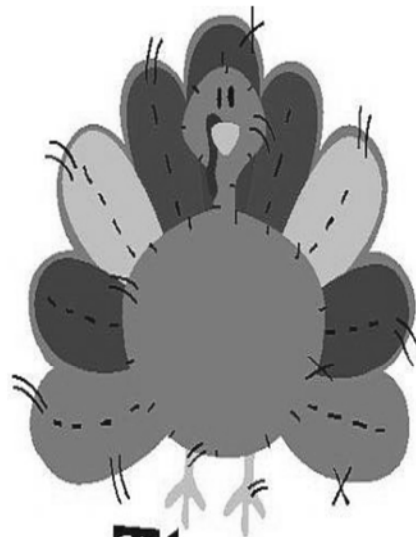

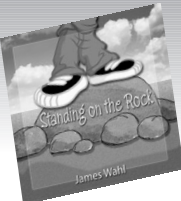
