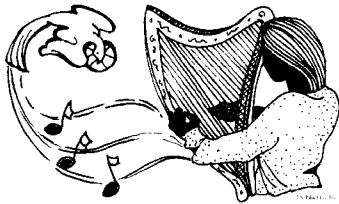

If you have a cold, be careful about shaking hands, even during the Sign of Peace, and avoid drinking from the chalice containing the Blood of Christ. If you receive the Body of Christ only, you receive all the Eucharistic Lord. He is not divided between the host and the chalice. You do not lose grace by receiving communion under one species.

There are boxes of tissues in the church. If you use a tissue, please do not leave it in the pew. There are waste cans in the rest rooms. Let's do all we can to have a healthy parish during the cold and flu season.

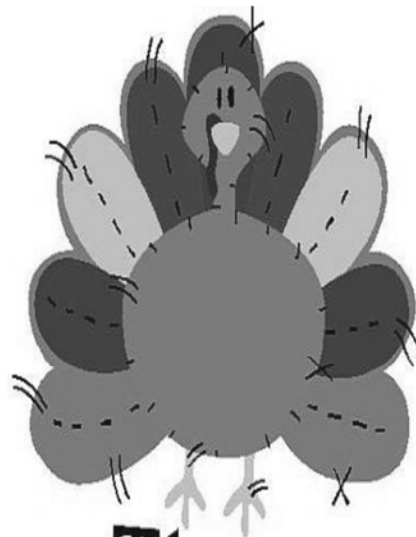

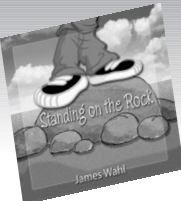
