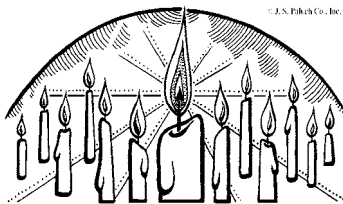

Second Reading — All those who call upon the name of the Lord are called to be holy. (1 Corinthians 1:1-3)

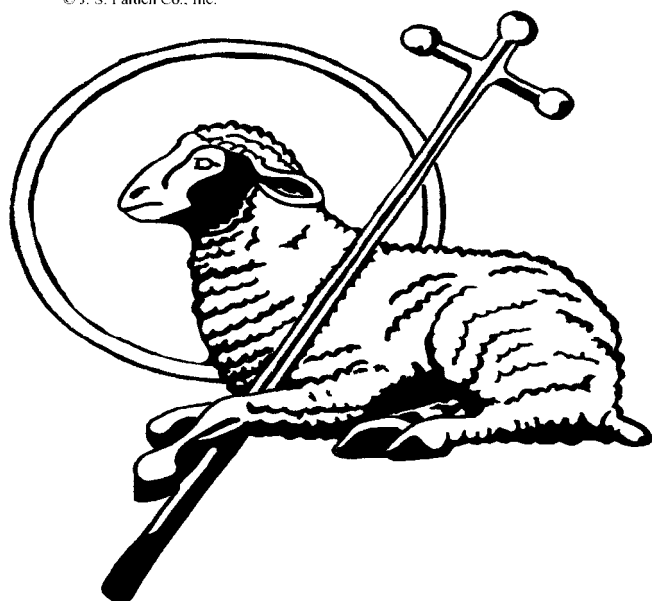
Gospel — John the Baptist testifies: The one who comes after me, on whom the Spirit comes down and remains, is the Son of God. (John 1:29-34)

After the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, the Church goes through a brief period (7 weeks) of what is called “Ordinary Time”. The word “ordinary” comes from the word “ordinal”, which means to hit a target or reach a goal. The military term for rockets, bullets, and other objects projected toward a target is “ordnance”. During Ordinary Time, we walk with the disciples following Jesus as He leads them and us to the kingdom of Heaven.

During 2020 the Sunday gospel readings for Ordinary Time come from the Gospel of Matthew. In the Gospel of Matthew, the Church is the New Israel, led by Jesus instead of Moses. Jesus leads us by His words and actions to the new Promised Land—the kingdom of Heaven. We are not hearing about things that happened in the past. We are hearing about things that **began** in the past and are still relevant for today. Every Sunday is the Lord’s Day and, therefore, an important day.

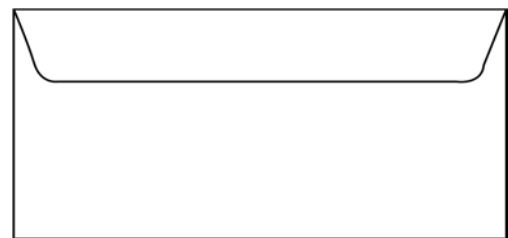

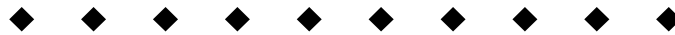
