The Diocese of Birmingham has asked us to exercise the following precautions and protocols to minimize the potential for coronavirus and flu spread:

- If you are sick or are experiencing symptoms of sickness, you are not obligated to attend Mass, and even out of charity, you should not attend.
- The sign of peace will be exchanged, however physical contact should be avoided.
- The distribution of Holy Communion from the Chalice will be suspended until further notice.
- Communion on the hand or tongue remains at the discretion of the communicant.

Pray for the families of those who are sick or have died. As they worry and grieve, defend them from illness and despair.
