Job Opening

Sonya Lewis, our current Director of Religious Education (DRE), has decided to resign her position, effective June 6th. We will begin the process of hiring a new DRE in April. This is a part-time position (25 hours per week). If you or someone you know is interested, contact Father Bill at the church office.

Status of the Religious Education Building

With the excess of rain in February, leaks were discovered in the Religious Education Building used on Sundays. Upon further examination, it was determined that water was entering through the window casements on the East side of the building.

All of the parish's property is owned by the Diocese of Birmingham, which is self-insured. All of the contributions and payments of the fund are made by the Diocese. A representative of the Diocese made an inspection on March 9th and an adjuster for the insurance company that manages the fund made an inspection on March 10th. When their reports are given to us, we can proceed to address the problems with the building.

First we must remedy the leaks, then we will have to repair the damage caused by the leaks. We will have to hire an outside contractor for this work. There will be a deductible of less than \$2000 and the rest will be paid by the Diocesan insurance.

Until the repairs are complete, the building will be closed for religious education classes and any other activities.
