Father Bill's Message

Dear Parishioners,

Most Reverend Robert Baker has issued a decree and guidelines for the restoration of public worship in the Diocese of Birmingham. **Beginning Friday, May 15th, Our Lady of the Lake Parish will return to its normal weekly Mass schedule**. Weekday masses will be as follows: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday at 9:00 a.m. and Wednesday at 7:00 p.m. Weekend masses will be Saturday at 5:00 p.m. and Sunday at 8:30 and 11:15 a.m. The sacrament of Reconciliation will be available from 4:00-4:45 on Saturday in the conference room in the parish hall.

<u>Bishop Baker has issued a new dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy days of Obligation. If you believe that it is not safe to be in crowds, that is reason enough to avoid attending Mass at this time.</u> We will continue to record the Saturday evening Mass for viewing on Facebook and You Tube.

The State of Alabama recommends the wearing of facial coverings and maintaining a six-foot distance between yourself and anyone who does not live in your household. These are recommended guidelines for everyone's safety. They are not requirements and we will do our best to accommodate everyone who shows up for Mass while trying to keep everyone safe. It may be that some people will have to watch Mass on a television in the parish hall.

The missalettes have been removed from the church. For weekend masses we plan to use a disposable worship booklet. If you have your own mass missal, (For example: Word Among Us or Our Daily Bread) you may want to bring it with you.

Because of the required social distancing, fewer liturgical ministers will be needed for each mass. New schedules are being developed. This weekend, ministers will be contacted by phone or email. Future schedules will be posted in the bulletin.

Communion will be available to all who wish to receive it. I ask that everyone disinfect their hands and remove gloves and face coverings before receiving communion in the hand. Hand sanitizer will be available, but you may want to bring your own. The ushers will direct you where to go to receive communion.

These restrictions may change once we have returned to our normal schedule and discover what works best for our parish. Please continue to pray for an end to the Covid-19 pandemic through the intercession of Mary, Mother of the Church.

Perfect Contrition and Spiritual Communion

What to do if you cannot go to Confession or Holy Communion due to the Covid-19 coronavirus



If you have to self-isolate or are quarantined due to the COVID-19 coronavirus, It is unlikely that you will be able to receive the sacraments as normal.

In these circumstances, there are devotions through which you can receive absolution for your sins (under certain conditions), and the consolation of Eucharistic grace.

These devotions are officially encouraged by the Church and have been practiced by saints.

How to make an Act of Perfect Contrition

Through an act of Perfect Contrition, you receive pardon for your sins outside of confession, even mortal sins, on condition that you determine to amend your life and make a firm resolution to go to sacramental confession as soon as this becomes possible for you.

Perfect Contrition is a grace from God, so sincerely ask for this gift throughout the day prior to making your act of contrition: "My God, grant me perfect contrition for all my sins".

- 1. In reality or imagination kneel at the foot of a crucifix and say to yourself; "Jesus, my God and my Savior, in the midst of your agony, you remembered me, you suffered for me, you wished to wipe away my sins".
- 2. Contrition is 'perfect' if you repent of your sins because you love God and are sorry for offending Him and causing the sufferings of Christ on the cross. Before the Crucified Christ remember your sins, repent of them because they have brought our Lord to his sufferings on the Cross. Promise him, that with His help, you will not sin again.
- 3. Recited, slowly and sincerely, an act of contrition focused on the goodness of God and your love of Jesus: "Od my God, because you are so good, I am very sorry that I have sinned against you and by the help of your grace I will not sin again. Amen".

How to make a Spiritual Communion

The key to Spiritual Communion is to grow in your heart a constant desire for the Blessed Sacrament.

- 1. If you are aware of serious or mortal sin, make an Act of Perfect Contrition.
- 2. Imagine the sacred words and action of the Mass or watch online or on TV.
- 3. Make all those acts of faith, humility, sorrow, adoration, love and desire that you usually express before Holy Communion.
- 4.. Desire, with earnest longing, to receive our Lord present Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity in the Blessed Sacrament.
- 5. Say this prayer of St. Alphonsus de' Ligouri: "My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Blessed Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire You in my soul. Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. As though You are already there, I embrace You and unite myself wholly to You; do not let me ever be separated from You. Amen.
- 6. After moments of silent adoration make all those acts of faith, humility, love, thanksgiving and offering that you usually express through prayers after Holy Communion.
