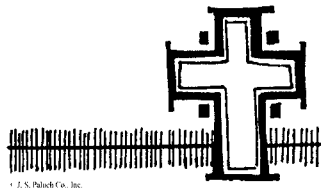

*Today's Readings*

## **ORDINARY TIME**

Beginning June 1, we entered into an extended section of the liturgical year called "Ordinary Time." It will last until the First Sunday of Advent (November 29<sup>th</sup>). The Gospel readings for Sunday will be primarily from the Gospel of Matthew and the color of the vestments will most often be green.

The word "ordinary" used here does not mean common or unimportant. It comes from the word "ordinal", which means to hit a target or reach a goal. Bombs, rockets, shells, and bullets are referred to as "ordnance" by the military. The goal or target we are trying to attain is what Matthew's Gospel calls the kingdom of Heaven.

The kingdom of Heaven is a relationship rather than a place. If Jesus Christ is our king, we are living in the kingdom of Heaven, wherever we are living. If we seek to do our own will rather than God's will, we are living in a kingdom of our own making rather than the kingdom of Heaven.

As is true of any good leader, Jesus leads by example. He shows us how to get to the kingdom of Heaven. We get there by imitating Him. He seeks to do the Father's will rather than His own. He seeks to please the Father rather than Himself or others. There is no secret to getting to the kingdom. Anyone can do it.

We can arrive at the kingdom of Heaven if we take His words to heart and imitate His example. There is a passage in Matthew's Gospel where Jesus says to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan!" The word "Satan" means "adversary". Jesus is saying to Peter, "Don't try to lead me where you want me to go. Follow me where I am leading you." Through our prayer, worship, and living, we are supposed to get in line behind Jesus as He leads us to the kingdom of Heaven.
