Father Bill's Message

WHAT IS FREEDOM?

One of the words we are likely to hear often this week is "Freedom". After all, July Fourth is Independence Day. This week we remember The Declaration of Independence and our revolt against being ruled by England.

In general, when people say they want to be free, they mean they want to do what they want, when they want, in the way they want, without hindrance from others. This is the two-year old's definition of freedom. Many people are emotional two-year olds, even if they are chronologically much older.

In the Bible, freedom is the ability to do what God wants, when God wants, in the way God wants, even if others attempt to hinder us from doing it. When Paul writes, "For freedom Christ set us free." (Galatians 5, 1), he is not saying we can do whatever we want. He is telling us that we cannot do God's will without God's help. Paul writes that even our desire to do good is a result of God's grace.

Christian freedom is freedom from being slaves to our passions and whims. It is freedom from being miserable unless we get our own way. It is freedom from being imprisoned in self-centeredness. Jesus was most free when He was nailed to a cross. That is because He was doing the Father's will perfectly.

Paul also wrote, "The flesh is opposed to the Spirit and the Spirit is opposed to the flesh." (Galatians 5, 17) The word Paul uses for "flesh" is "sarx". The definition of sarx is putting yourself ahead of everyone else. When we live as if we are the center of the universe, we are living in the flesh. When we live as if God is the center of the universe, we are living in the Spirit. The two lifestyles are opposed to each other. We must choose one. That choice is the beginning or end of our freedom.


