#### Father Bill's Weekly Message

#### **MIRACLES HAPPEN EVERY DAY**

Our Gospel readings at Mass recently have been from Chapter 13 of the Gospel of Matthew. In that Chapter, Jesus tells a series of parables which He claims describe the kingdom of Heaven.

The first of the parables is about a farmer who sows seeds. Most of the seeds fail to produce lasting growth. Some seed falls on "good soil" and produces a harvest, "a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold." Though that sounds like a lot, it is a normal harvest.

In Jesus' time, most farmers depended on a lot of factors beyond their control to have a successful harvest. A successful harvest was one that allowed them to survive. Rain fall, temperature, insects, and other factors could ruin their harvest and them. A normal harvest was a miracle. They could not achieve it without God.

As people who go to a grocery store to get what we want, we know very little about survival when it comes to food. In this and other ways we may have lost our sense of the miraculous in the ordinary. God is acting in our lives every day. When God is acting, it is a miracle. Miracles happen every day.

For two years I was the pastor of a parish that ran a school. I knew nothing about operating a school. When I awoke each morning, I prayed in desperation that God would somehow save our school. Later, I moved to another parish that did not have a school. I believed I was capable of handling my responsibilities. The sense of desperation disappeared from my prayer. I (kind of) missed it.

What replaced the sense of desperation was a desire to have God's will done in my life each day. I began to pray, "Father, whatever happens today, let it be according to Your will. Even if I do not know it, let it be according to Your will." At the end of the day I can recognize God's hand in many "ordinary" events. Usually, it is God preventing me from causing some disaster! When God is acting, it is a miracle. Miracles happen every day.

# Extension of Dispensation from Obligation to attend Holy Mass

On June 24th, Reverend Steven J.
Raica, Bishop of Birmingham in Alabama, extended the dispensation from the obligation to attend Holy Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation through Sunday, September 6, 2020.

He also reminds the faithful who, due to concerns about the COVID-19 and /or the prior suspension of public worship, have not fulfilled their "Easter Duty" (the Church's precept to confess mortal sins in number and kind and receive a worthy Holy Communion at least once a year, during the Lent or Easter season), to do so as soon as reasonably possible.


