HAPPY ANNIVERSARY!

The church for Our Lady of the Lake parish was dedicated by Bishop Joseph Vath on August 18, 1970. Since 1967, Catholics in Pell City had been meeting at the offices of the Coosa Valley Telephone Company. The parish was officially established by the Diocese of Birmingham in 1969.

Father Robert Bauler was the first pastor. Jean Brandli, who owned the telephone company, was the driving force in the founding and funding of the venture. The church building at the time consisted of what is today the center section. The north and south wings were added in the early 2000's.

Early Christians called the places where they met, "domo ecclesia", that is, "the house of the Church". This was an acknowledgement that they had met for worship in people's homes in the beginning. It was also a statement of belief that Christians are brothers and sisters in Christ. When we gather for worship, we are a family. We belong to each other because of our common relationship with Jesus Christ.

When the word "Church" is used in the New Testament, it refers to people. The word itself means, "those who belong to the Lord". However, God created us with bodies and, therefore, we need a place to gather and a structure that helps us worship God together. That is why the Church needs a church.

We can gather here at our Lady of the Lake church because of the lived faith of many people over 50+ years. We are part of something greater than ourselves. The 50th anniversary of the dedication of our church is an opportunity to give thanks to God for the faith of those who have gone before us.






