#### FIRST COMMUNION

This Sunday, September 13<sup>th</sup>, five of our parish children will make their First Communion. They are doing it at a special Mass in order to maintain social distancing for them and their families. They were supposed to receive it on Mother's Day in May, but there were no Masses with a Congregation at that time.

This event is one of my favorites as a priest. It is a day of joy. It is a day of reverence. It is a day when the importance of the sacrament of the Eucharist is clearly seen by all who witness the liturgy. The loving looks on the faces of the parents as their children receive communion for the first time is a sight to behold!

I made my First Communion in 1965. The boys were dressed like little grooms- black pants, white coats, white shirts, and black bow ties. The girls were dressed like little brides- white dresses and shoes with long white veils. The boys sat on one side of the church and the girls on the other. (I am not sure if there was any meaning to that.) For the whole Mass I worried that I might make a mistake: I might genuflect wrong or let the host touch my teeth. I don't remember any of the prayers or hymns or readings. I was too nervous.

Today, I try to let the children know what a special day this is. I remind them that Jesus is coming very close to them. Jesus loves them and wants to be near them always! It is easy for them to believe that on this particular Sunday with the special Mass and the special clothes. It might be more difficult for them to believe it the next Sunday or the Sunday after that. Yet, anytime we receive communion it is a special occasion. Anytime we receive communion Jesus Christ is showing His love for us by feeding us- with Himself! Jesus is giving Himself completely to us and for us.

Maybe this weekend can be an opportunity for each of us to remember the special day when we made our First Communion. Jesus loves us just as much today as He did then.


