Father Bill's Weekly Message

Five Loaves and Two Fish

Cardinal Francis Xavier Nguyen Van Thuan was a Vietnamese Cardinal who was imprisoned by the Communist Government from 1977-1990. He spent nine of those years in solitary confinement. He wrote a book about his experience in prison called, Five Loaves and Two Fish.

Cardinal Van Thuan relates a story about how he decided to celebrate Mass one day- in his prison cell. He took a crumb from his bread ration, recited the Mass prayers from memory, and put the consecrated "host" in the mortar between two bricks in the wall. In that way, his prison cell became a chapel. Jesus Christ was present to him in the eucharist even in his confinement. From that day until his release from solitary confinement years later, he was always aware of God's presence with him, even as his jailers tried to break his faith. His prison cell became a place to worship God.

Cardinal Van Thuan's faith grew during his confinement. It grew **because** of his confinement. The Communist government tried to destroy his faith. All they accomplished was to make his faith more pure. He could have descended into self-pity or despair. He could have complained about his situation or blamed his suffering on others. Instead, he put his faith in God; that God would take care of him in all circumstances.

For almost 200 years (1592-1777), the Catholic Church in Korea existed without priests! They had the sacrament of Baptism, the scriptures, and "churches" located in people's houses. They had no Mass or other sacraments. They were members of a "hidden" Church. But they had faith.

The restrictions on worship of Co-Vid 19 are an opportunity for our faith to be purified. Like Cardinal Van Thuan or the Korean Catholics of the 17th and 18th centuries, we have an opportunity to depend more on God in a time of deprivation. How are we doing? Is **our** faith being purified?
