A letter from Father Bill Lucas: (Reprinted and Updated from October 14, 2018)

Dear parishioners,

At our recent meetings where parishioners asked questions and gave feedback on the situation in the Church concerning the safety of our young people, it became clear that information is helpful and secrets are harmful. Everyone who attended agreed that we need to be vigilant in protecting the children and adolescents of our community.

Currently, all Diocesan employees and volunteers are subject to a criminal background check and must take a course in youth protection before they can be accepted for their paid or volunteer position that involves contact with minors. In our parish, Kelly Cardenas, our Director of Religious Education, makes certain that all volunteers are up to date on the background check and youth protection training. As pastor, I am responsible for keeping up with the training and background checks of the paid staff.

The reason for the certification in youth protection is so that employees and volunteers can be alert to the possibility that a child or adolescent in the parish may be suffering some type of abuse. They are then supposed to report their concerns to Kelly or me so that we can get basic information and inform local civil authorities and the Diocesan Office of Youth and Child Protection. It is important that an investigation is performed by people qualified to do so.

All of us can be child and youth protectors. The catch phrase is, "See Something? Say Something!" If you see an adult behaving in an inappropriate manner with a child or adolescent, speak up. If it is in the parish, tell me. If it is in the community, tell the people in charge of overseeing the child: the school principal, the day-care director, the head of the youth sports program, or if all else fails, local law enforcement. You do not need to prove anything. Your duty is to report suspicious behavior. Even if it turns out there is no abuse, better to report the behavior than ignore it.

The abuse of children and adolescents is a tragedy. Through prayer and vigilance let us all do our part to protect our young people so they can grow up in a safe and nurturing environment.


