Father Bill's Weekly Message

ADVENT

Today we begin the liturgical season of Advent. It is a time of preparation for Christmas. The word "Advent" means, "Coming". According to St. Bernard, there are three comings of the Lord. There was the coming of Jesus Christ, fully human and fully divine, in the Incarnation. There is the "Second Coming" of the Lord Jesus at the end of time. There is the coming of Jesus Christ each day in the Holy Spirit.

The first part of Advent (November 29th through December 16th this year) focuses on the Second Coming of Christ. The second part of Advent (December 17th through the 24th) focuses on the first coming of Christ. Each day of Advent, we focus on the coming of Christ in the Holy Spirit. Keeping Advent prepares us to celebrate Christmas with minds and hearts renewed.

Because of the commercialism associated with the secular observance of Christmas, it is challenging to prepare spiritually for it. Advent is a penitential season. (Notice that the Gloria is not prayed on the Sundays of Advent.) The primary disciplines of Lent are prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. There is no reason these cannot be employed during Advent.

Spending more time in prayer can always be beneficial. The Advent wreath is meant to be a means of daily prayer in preparation for Christmas. Fasting or "giving up" something can be a way of adding discipline to our life in a time of stress. Almsgiving is an imitation of God's generosity to the poor. Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are equally appropriate during Advent as they are during Lent.

This year, Advent lasts 26 days. It is shorter than Lent. That means keeping the disciplines of this penitential season is easier because the length of time is shorter. It also means there is no time to waste. It will be over before we know it. As we hear in the Gospel, "Now is the time." Through our observance of Advent, may Christmas find us ready to welcome Christ with minds and hearts renewed.

DECREE EXTENDING THE DISPENSATION FROM THE SUNDAY AND HOLY DAY MASS OBLIGATION DUE TO COVID-19

In accordance with canons 87 § 1 and 90 of the Code of Canon Law, I make the following provision, recognizing that infection rates for COVID-19 remain generally high in the territory of the Diocese of Birmingham in Alabama and that the dispensation I previously extended on August 19, 2020 shall soon expire, on November 22, 2020:

I herby extend the dispensation from the obligation to assist at Holy Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation through <u>Sunday</u>, <u>January 10</u>, <u>2021</u> (inclusive) —the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord and the conclusion of the Christmas Season—for all the Roman Catholic faithful who reside in the Diocese of Birmingham in Alabama.
