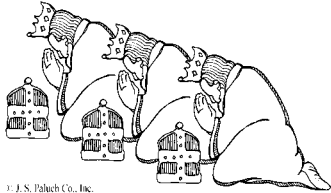

Today's Readings

THE PRECEPTS OF THE CHURCH

At the beginning of the calendar year, it might be good to remind ourselves about these minimum requirements for all Catholics. Please note: Bishop Raica has issued a Dispensation from #1 for those who believe being in a crowd would be dangerous to their health.

What are the precepts? According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church: "Positive laws made by the Church authorities to guarantee for the faithful the indispensable minimum in prayer and moral effort, for the sake of their growth in love of God and neighbor."

(Catechism Glossary)

There are Five:

- 1) You shall attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor. (In the Diocese of Birmingham, all Sundays and January 1, August 15, November 1, December 8, and December 25).
- 2) You shall confess your sins as least once a year.
- 3) You shall receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season. (From Easter Sunday through Pentecost Sunday).
- 4) You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church. (Required days of fast-Ash Wednesday and Good Friday for those ages 14-59. Required days of abstinence from meat-Those days, plus all the Friday of Lent for those ages 14 and older).
- 5) You shall help to provide for the needs of the Church.

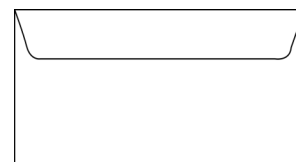
