

Today's Readings

THE MEMORIAL OF SAINT BLAISE

Wednesday, February 3rd is the Memorial of St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr. The legend is that, on his way to martyrdom, Blaise prayed over a boy who had a fish bone lodged in his throat and the boy coughed up the bone. Since the Middle Ages, February 3rd has been the day to offer a blessing of throats.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the Diocese of Birmingham has recommended not to do an individual blessing of throats this year. The Book of Blessings does provide the option of doing a communal blessing over a group, using the same prayer formula for the individual blessing:

Through the intercession of St. Blaise,

Bishop and martyr,

May God deliver you from every

Disease of the throat and from every other illness:

In the name of the Father, and of the Son,

And of the Holy Spirit.

Even if you receive this blessing, you should still follow your doctor's directions. You should still take whatever medicine is needed if you have a sickness. You should still get vaccinated, if necessary, to protect others as well as yourself. God also inspires doctors, nurses, and pharmacists to be instruments of His healing power. It is possible that God heals people through medicine. God's providence takes many forms. Sometimes God bestows His grace through others.
