Father Bill's Weekly Message

CHANGES IN THE MASS

On May 3rd, Bishop Raica issued a decree stating that the Dispensation for Attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation that ends on May 23rd will not be renewed. The following day, Governor Ivey issued a decree stating that all emergency health orders would end on May 31st, including the Guidelines for Places of Worship. That being the case, the following changes are planned for the celebration of the liturgy at Our Lady of the Lake:

The Weekend of May 23rd:

The pews will be divided, with 50% being designated for social distancing and 50% for open seating (no ropes in two of the four sections of pews). The live-streaming of Mass will be discontinued after May 22nd.

Beginning June 1st:

- Communicants have the option of receiving communion on the tongue or the hand.
- The Holy Water Fonts will be re-filled. The automatic Holy Water dispensers will still be available for use.
- The gifts and collection will be brought in procession to the sanctuary during the offertory at Sunday and Holy Day Masses.
- The nursery will be available for Sunday morning Masses.
- Ministers of Holy Communion who have received the Covid Vaccine or who have recovered from the virus may distribute communion without wearing a mask.
- Ushers who have received the Covid vaccine or who have recovered from the virus may take up the collection without wearing a mask.
- With the relaxation of the previous restrictions, more liturgical ministers will be needed. If you have been or would like to begin serving the parish as a Lector, Minister of Holy Communion, Usher, Greeter, Altar Server, or Cantor, please consult the bulletin or contact Father Bill in person after Mass.

Please consider donating \$1 per week


BELL TOWER FUND DRIVE

The parish has received architectural renderings for a tower to house a bell. The bell has been purchased and fitted for automatic ringing. The total cost of the project is approximately \$100,000. We have a pledge of \$30,000 and collected an additional \$4,457 as of May 9, 2021. The rest of the cost will need to be raised <u>before</u> a contract can be signed by Bishop Raica and construction can begin.

END OF THE DISPENSATION FROM ATTENDING MASS ON SUNDAYS AND HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION

On May 3rd, Bishop Raica issued a decree confirming that when the current Dispensation from attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation expires on May 24th, it will not be renewed. There are those who may be excused from the obligation for a serious reason:

- Being advised by a medical doctor that it is not safe for you to participate in public activities.
- Experiencing a high amount of mental distress over the prospect of returning to public activities.
- Having symptoms of COVID-19 or another serious/contagious illness.
- Caring for an infant or someone who has a serious illness.

If you have any questions about how this decree applies to you, please ask Father Bill.






