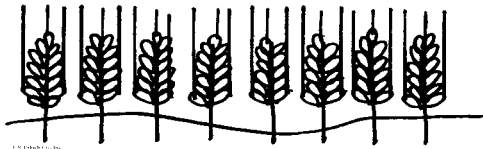

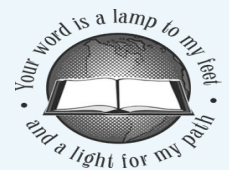

## **CHANGE AND ADAPTATION**

When change comes, I dislike it at first, but then I adapt to it so that what was once new becomes familiar. Then the next change happens and the process starts again. I suppose this process is how I survive and function.

It occurred to me recently that perhaps it is not always healthy to adapt to change. Some changes are not good. I can acquire habits that are bad for me physically, emotionally, and spiritually. I can adapt to these “new” habits and lose ground, spiritually.

The past year has forced most of us to adapt to new behaviors concerning the Mass. Social distancing, face coverings, and increased vigilance concerning sanitariness were all part of the changes we adapted to. For some of us, that included watching Mass from a distance on a computer screen. Many of us were forced to adapt to these changes, but it can still be difficult to leave them behind and change again by returning to personal participation in the Mass.

It is important that we do so. The prayers, the feasts, the readings of the Mass are the same, but we are supposed to be different. God never changes, but we do. Those changes are supposed to lead us closer to God. It is a grace that televised and live-streamed masses exist for those who are physically unable to get to a church. For the rest of us, there is no substitute for personal participation in the Mass. It is there that we receive the sacraments that strengthen us to adapt our minds and wills to the mind and will of Jesus Christ.

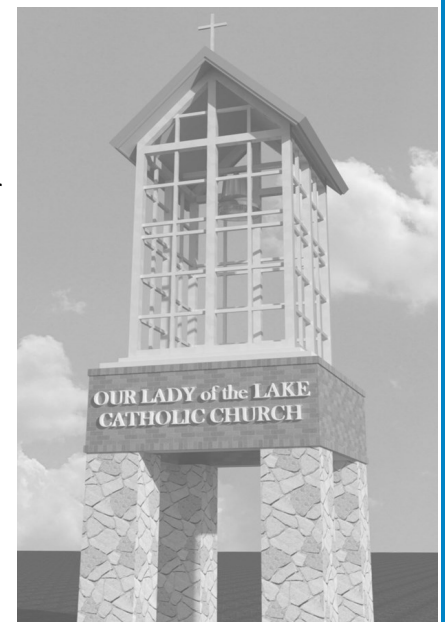

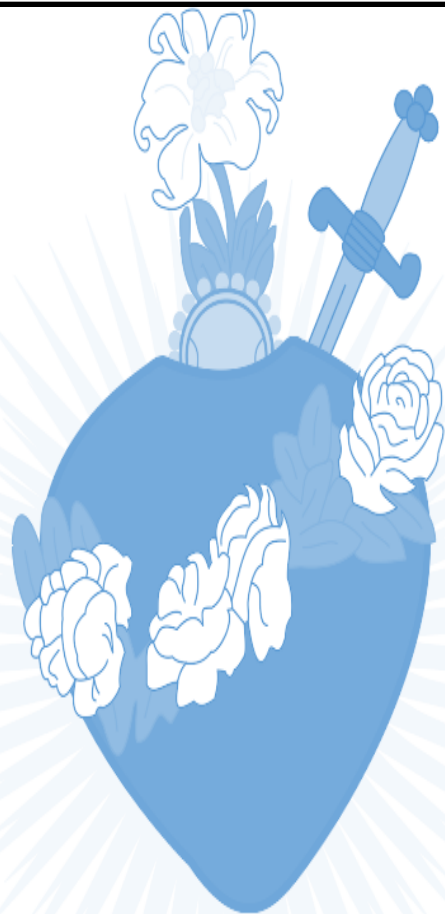
