WHO IS IN CONTROL?

The founders of Alcoholics Anonymous developed what has become known as The Serenity Prayer: "God, grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change, courage to change the things I can, and wisdom to know the difference." (That is the shortened version.)

Alcoholics Anonymous and, indirectly, all 12-Step programs are patterned after the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola from the 16th century. Both include a daily "Examination of Conscious" where a person reviews the events of their day to determine what God's will is for them and whether or not they are following it.

There are some things under our control and some things beyond our control. It takes divine wisdom to discern the difference. Our problem can sometimes be that we get agitated over things that are beyond our control. It is easy to recognize when this is happening. When we become insistent that other people change what they are doing to conform to what we want them to do, we are worrying about realities beyond our control. I have caused much suffering to myself and others by worrying about realities beyond my control.

Pope St. John Paul II wrote, "Everything depends on God, but God has seen fit to make some things depend on us. The problem is that we do not consult God enough about what depends on Him and what depends on us. Perhaps we can begin or end each day by asking God, "What do you ask of me, Lord?" Then do no more or no less than what God asks.


BELL TOWER FUND DRIVE UPDATE


