REJOICE AND BE GLAD

In 2018, Pope Francis authored an Apostolic Exhortation, <u>Gaudete et Exsultate</u>, or in English, <u>Rejoice and Be Glad</u>. I am not aware of anyone, clergy or lay person, who has commented on it. Perhaps it wasn't controversial enough.

In Paragraph Two, the Pope explains the purpose of the document: "My modest goal is to repropose the call to holiness in a practical way for our own time." The document has no new teaching. It is meant to be an application of the Church's Tradition of the Call to Holiness in the modern world. All Catholics are called to grow in holiness.

The Holy Father goes on to quote from "Lumen Gentium", the Dogmatic Constitution on the Church from the Second Vatican Council: "(I)t has pleased God to make men and women holy and to save them, not as individuals without any bond between them, but rather as a people who might acknowledge him in truth and serve him in holiness. (LG, #9) The Pope goes on to write, "We are never completely ourselves unless we belong to a people. That is why no one is saved alone, as an isolated individual." (G&E, #6) In the bible, there is no individual salvation, only corporate salvation.

The first Chapter of the document is entitled, "The Call to Holiness." He quotes from Pope Emeritus Benedict, "holiness is nothing more than charity lived to the full. The measure of our holiness stems from the stature that Christ achieves in us." (#21) Charity is Christ loving others through us. This is similar to what the Apostle Paul writes in Galatians, Chapter 2, verse 20: "It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me." The more Jesus Christ directs our lives, the more we grow in holiness.


BELL TOWER FUND




