

## Today's Readings



**First Reading** — I shall gather the remnant of my flock and bring them back to their meadow (Jeremiah 23:1-6).

## TWO SUBTLE ENEMIES OF HOLINESS

In Chapter Two of his Apostolic Exhortation, Rejoice and Be Glad, Pope Francis explains two philosophies that hinder one from growing in holiness. They do so because they proceed from a false understanding of the nature of God as Creator and human beings as creatures made, "in the image and likeness of God." (Genesis 1)

The first philosophy Pope Francis calls "Gnosticism". It presumes "a purely subjective faith whose only interest is a certain experience or set of ideas," (#36) This is seen today in people who claim to decide who is and who is not "truly Catholic". The Pope goes on to write, "If we let ourselves be guided by the Spirit rather than by our own preconceptions, we can and must try to find the Lord in every human life." (#42) Gnosticism tries to limit the scope of God's activity and can close people off from finding ways of growing in holiness.

The other philosophy the Pope says hinders us from growing in holiness is "Pelagianism". Pelagianism teaches that one can attain holiness through human effort and force of will. This is often seen in people who are obsessed with books, ritual practice, and minute details of the faith. They believe in quantifying holiness by the numbers of prayers they can say in a particular time period.

Pope Francis quotes from the Council of Trent: "Grace proceeds, accompanies and follows all our actions." (DH 1525) He goes on to write, "Only on the basis of God's gift, freely accepted and humbly received, can we cooperate by our own efforts in our progressive transformation." (#56) Holiness is God's gift to us rather than our gift to God. Even our cooperation with God's grace is because of that same grace. (#53) Numbers of prayers are no substitute for a living relationship with the Living God.






