## IN THE LIGHT OF THE MASTER

In Chapter Three of Pope Francis's Apostolic Exhortation, <u>Rejoice and Be Glad</u>, the Pope comments on The Beatitudes (Chapter 5, 3-12) and the Corporal Works of Mercy (Chapter 25, 31-46) from the Gospel of Matthew. These teachings are not only advice on how to live a Christian life. They reveal the heart of Jesus Christ, our Lord.

Concerning the Beatitudes, Pope Francis writes, "We can only practice them if the Holy Spirit fills us with his power and frees us from our weakness, our selfishness, our complacency, and our pride." (#65) We can only live the Beatitudes by growing in holiness.

The Pope goes on to write, "(The word 'Blessed') expresses the fact that those faithful to God and his word, by their self-giving, gain true happiness." (#64) By offering the gift of self in service to Jesus Christ, we will become holy people.

The Pope then offers a reflection on what are traditionally known as the Corporal Works of Mercy. Here he quotes St. Teresa of Calcutta: "Yes, I have many human faults and failures... But God bends down and uses us, you and me, to be his love and his compassion in the world; he bears our sins, our troubles, and our faults. He depends on us to love the world and to show how much he loves it." (#107)

Holiness does not make us withdraw from the world. Rather, we live in the world as God's instruments of mercy. Quoting from Pope St. John Paul II: "If we truly start out anew from the contemplation of Christ, we must learn to see him especially in the face of those with whom he himself wished to be identified." (#96) We cannot love God unless we love our neighbor as well. Everyone is our neighbor. (1John 3, 17-18)






