

SIGNS OF HOLINESS IN TODAY'S WORLD

Chapter Four of Pope Francis's Apostolic Exhortation, Rejoice and Be Glad deals with signs of holiness in the Twenty-First Century. The Pope begins by saying: "I will not pause to explain the means of sanctification already known to us: the various methods of prayer, the inestimable sacraments of the Eucharist and Reconciliation, the offering of personal sacrifices, different forms of devotion, spiritual direction, and many others." (#110) He goes on to add, "The signs I wish to highlight are... five great expressions of love of God and neighbor I consider of particular importance...in today's culture". (#111)

The first is, "solid grounding in the God who loves and sustains us." (#112)
This source of inner strength allows us to persevere, to be patient, and to be meek
in the face of obstacles and persecutions.

The second is "Joy and a Sense of Humor." The Pope points to the saints, who are, "joyful and full of good humor. Though completely realistic, they radiate a positive and hopeful spirit." (#122) He quotes St. Thomas Aquinas: "since every lover rejoices in being united with the beloved...the effect of charity is joy."

The third is "Boldness and Passion." Pope Francis uses the word, *parrhesia*, which he says means, "boldness, an impulse to evangelize and leave a mark in this world." (#129)

The fourth is, "In Community." Here he writes, "Growth in holiness is a journey in community, side by side with others. (#141) He continues, "our path to holiness can only make us identify all the more with Jesus' prayer "that all may be one; even as you, Father, are in me, and I in you." (John 17, 21) (#146)

The fifth is, "In Constant Prayer." The Pope writes, "holiness consists in a habitual openness to the transcendent, expressed in prayer and adoration." (#147) In the end, our desire for God will surely find expression in our daily lives. (#148) (Next Week: "Spiritual Combat, Vigilance, and Discernment")




