Father Bill's Weekly Message

THE ROSARY

October is the Month of the Rosary. That is because the Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary falls on October 7th. Pope Pius XII wrote, "The Rosary is a compendium of the Gospel." We meditate on Jesus' birth, ministry, death, and resurrection. Hopefully, over time these events have an increasing impact on our relationship with Jesus Christ and an increasing impact on our lives.

The rosary is a prayer of meditation. We meditate on key events from the life of Christ. The recitation of prayers is supposed to keep our mind from wandering as we focus on the mysteries. Each decade usually takes around three minutes to pray. That is three minutes to meditate on a particular mystery.

As we pray, the Blessed Virgin Mary is praying with us and for us. She was present at most of the mysteries. From her place in Heaven, she understands the depth of meaning for each event from the life of her son and Lord. What better person to be with us as we pray?

In his 2002 Apostolic Letter, <u>The Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary</u>, Pope St. John Paul II wrote about contemplating the face of Christ with Mary: "To look upon the face of Christ to recognize its mystery amid the daily events and sufferings of his human life, and then to grasp divine splendor definitively revealed in the Risen Lord seated in glory at the right hand of the Father; this is the task of every follower of Christ and therefore the task of each one of us. In contemplating Christ's face, we become open to the mystery of Trinitarian life, experiencing ever anew the love of the Father and delighting in the joy of the Holy Spirit."

The goal is that we would be transformed into the same image. (See 2Corinthians 3, 18)




