Collins Hess, a seminarian being sponsored by the Diocese of Birmingham, will be living and ministering in our parish for six weeks beginning June 5th. Collins is from St. John the Baptist parish in Madison, Alabama. He has completed his pre-theology studies at The Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, Ohio. He will begin his first year of graduate studies in Theology in August.

A seminarian's summer assignment is an opportunity for him to get to know the Diocese of Birmingham, its priests and people, and discern further his vocation to the priesthood. Collins will be involved in parish activities, liturgies, and pastoral ministry. He is not a deacon, so he cannot preach, but this is an opportunity to apply his seminary studies to a Catholic parish.







STATEMENT HORRIFYING IMAGES EMERGING FROM UVALDE, TEXAS May 25, 2022
