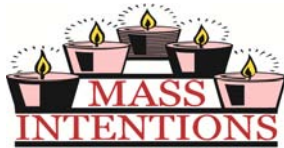

## Today's Readings

## **DISTRIBUTION OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD**

Bishop Raica has granted permission to return to the practice of offering the Precious Blood of the Lord at Mass. We will begin offering it at all Masses beginning the weekend of June 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup>, the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi).

The Catholic Doctrine of Concomitance teaches that when we receive communion under the form of bread alone, we receive the whole Christ, body, blood, soul, and divinity. Therefore, receiving the Precious Blood is always optional. The sign is more complete when the communicant receives the host and from the chalice, but the grace of the sacrament is given completely under either sacramental form.

The practice of intinction, that is, dipping the consecrated host into the Precious Blood is reserved only to the priest at the altar. It may not be practiced in the communion line. (We want to avoid spilling the Precious Blood.)

Beginning next weekend, we will return to the previous method of distributing communion. There will be two stations in the center aisle of the church where the consecrated hosts will be distributed. On either side of those stations, the Precious Blood will be available. As always, those who need communion brought to them will be served by the Ministers of the Host.

If there is another period of widely transmittable sickness, the Precious Blood may not be available for a time. We will bring it back when the situation returns to "normal." Please, if you are sick, be considerate of the needs of others and avoid large gatherings. The virtue of Prudence is still required.

## **FIRST SATURDAY MASS**

Our parish will begin offering a First Saturday Mass at 9:00 a.m. on July 2<sup>nd</sup>. This will be offered on a temporary basis for six months to see if there is interest in the parish for this devotion.

At Fatima, Mary promised to those who made the five consecutive First Saturdays that she would assist them at the hour of death with the grace of perseverance, which is necessary for salvation. To fulfill the devotion one must pray the rosary, go to confession, and receive communion, then spend 15 minutes in meditation on one of the mysteries of the rosary.

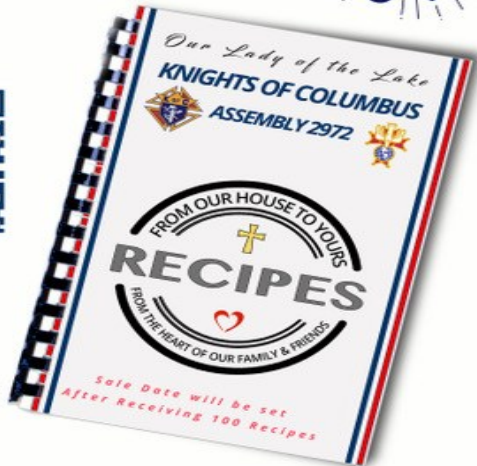

## EUCCHARISTIC REVIVAL FORTY HOURS DEVOTION JUNE 17-JUNE 19, 2022 CATHEDRAL OF ST PAUL

The United State Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has called for a Eucharistic Revival, a three-year "grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist." Particularly right now, the bishops feel the Church in the United States needs (1) healing, (2) unity, (3) formation, and (4) sending. The mission of the revival is to renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. Locally, we will prepare for the Eucharistic Revival with a Forty Hours Devotion, beginning June 17th at the Cathedral of St. Paul. The devotion will culminate with a Eucharistic procession through the streets of downtown Birmingham on June 19th, The Feast of Corpus Christi, at 7:00 pm. 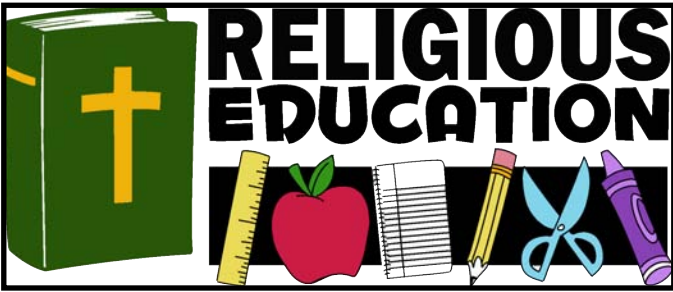

### *The Blessed Trinity!*

Today, we celebrate the feast of the Blessed Trinity. The word Trinity is a title for God that tells us that He is three Persons in one God.

Before Jesus came, the people didn't know that God was a Trinity. The Israelites knew that there was only one God, but they didn't know very much about Him. Jesus showed the people that there were three Persons in God when he taught them about Himself and the Father and the Holy Spirit.

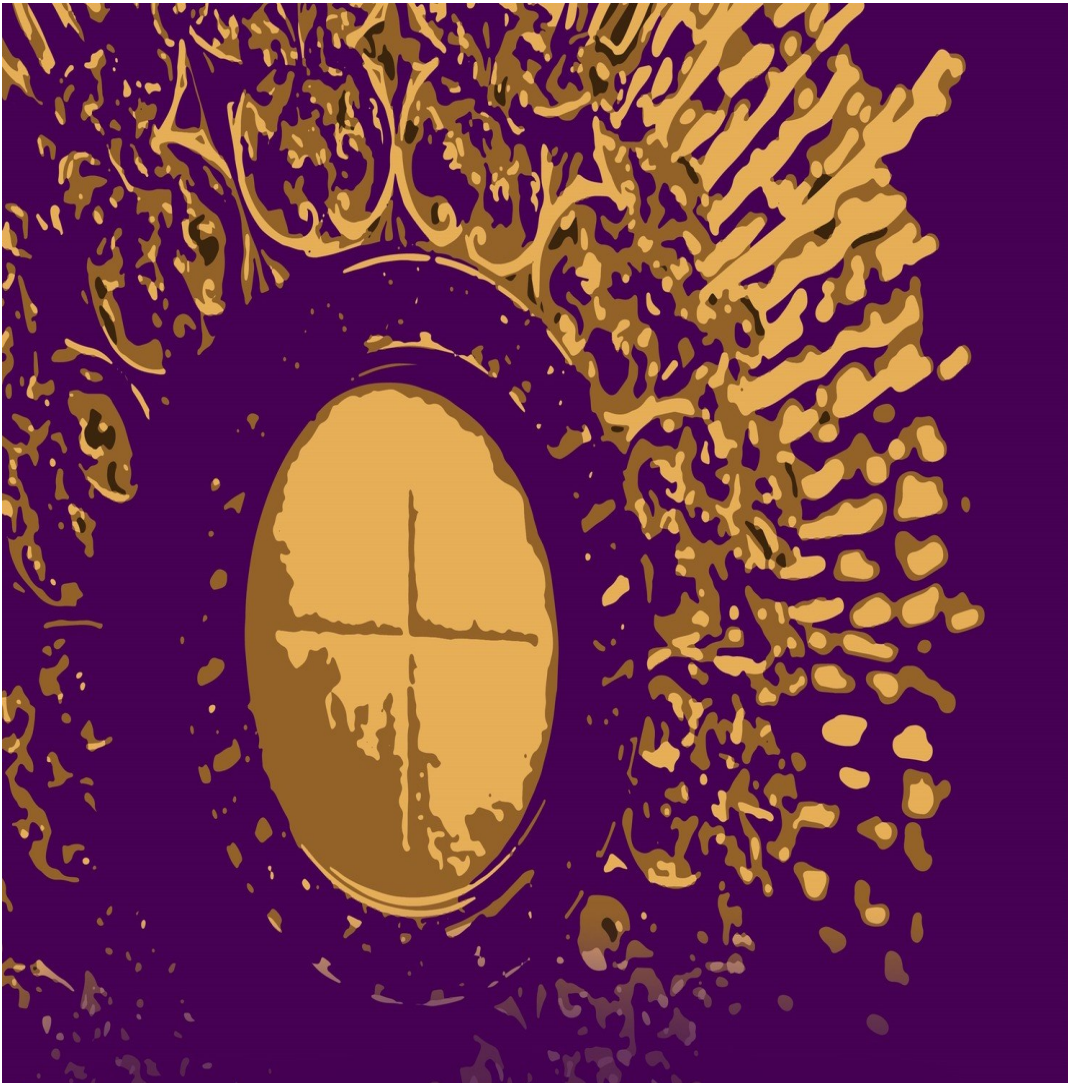
