#### Father Bill's Weekly Message

#### MISSIONARY SPIRIT

This weekend parishes throughout the Diocese of Birmingham will be taking up a collection for the Mission Cooperative Appeal. Six dioceses in Central America, Africa and Asia will receive the funds collected throughout our diocese.

The Church founded by Jesus Christ is missionary in nature. It continues the mission of Jesus Christ to draw all people to God. In the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus commissions the Apostles: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And, behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." (28, 18-20) The Church is called to "go forth" and bring the Gospel to the world.

While the number of Christians is declining in Europe and North America, it is remaining steady in Central America and increasing in Asia and Africa. The Catholic Church is also finding more vocations on these continents than in the Northern Hemisphere. Look around the Diocese of Birmingham and you can see the increasing number of priests from India, Cameroon, and Nigeria. Without these men, many of our parishes would be without a priest and, therefore, without the Mass.

While Asia and Africa have increasing numbers of religious vocations, the societies that produce them are very poor. The Mission Cooperative Collection provides resources to spread the Gospel in these developing countries. It allows these dioceses to continue the work of the Church to draw all people to Christ.

As the Catholic Diocese of Birmingham, we are not in competition with other Catholic dioceses throughout the United States or throughout the world. We are in a relationship of cooperation. We are helping each other so that Jesus Christ may be known and loved by more people. Please be generous to the Mission Cooperative Appeal.

Our parish will begin offering a First Saturday Mass at 9:00 a.m. on July 2<sup>nd</sup>. This will be offered on a temporary basis for six months to see if there is interest in the parish for this devotion.






#### Follow Jesus


