Father Bill's Weekly Message

THE PRIESTHOOD

A priest is a minister of Jesus Christ. A minister is one who serves. First, the priest serves Jesus Christ. His duty is to serve Jesus Christ in all he does. Second, he is an instrument Jesus Christ uses to serve His people. For example, when a priest pronounces absolution in the sacrament of Reconciliation, it is Jesus Christ who is forgiving sins.

"The priesthood of presbyters is conferred by a special sacrament which, by the anointing of the holy Spirit, puts a special stamp on them and so conforms them to Christ the priest in such a way that they are able to act in the person of Christ the head." ("Ministry and Life of Priests, #2)

During the Eucharistic Prayer, the priest stands at the "head" of the altar because he is acting, "in persona Christi capitas"- in "the person of Christ the head". In a way, the priest himself should disappear, so that people will recognize only Christ. There is only one priesthood, that of Jesus Christ, and the priest has a share in it.

One of the duties of a priest, both Old and New Testament, is to intercede to God for the needs of others. He does this during the sacramental liturgy, especially the Mass. He also does it during his personal prayer. A priest is a "man for others".

A priest is a leader, but he is a servant leader. He shepherds sheep who are not his own. The flock belongs to Jesus Christ. But He chooses shepherds to tend and nurture His flock; to bind up their wounds, to defend them from predators, and help them find sustenance.

"The whole Christian people ought to be made aware that it is their duty to cooperate in their various ways, both in earnest prayer and by other means available to them, to ensure that the church will always have those priests who are needed for the fulfillment of its divine mission." (Ministry and Life of Priests", #11)

FIRST SATURDAY MASS

We will continue with our First Saturday Mass in August. The Mass will be held at 9:00 a.m. on August 6th. These Masses will be offered on a temporary basis for six months to see if there is interest in the parish for this devotion.

At Fatima, Mary promised to those who made the five consecutive First Saturdays that she would assist them at the hour of death with the grace of perseverance, which is necessary for salvation. To fulfill the devotion one must pray the rosary, go to confession, and receive communion, then spend 15 minutes in meditation on one of the mysteries of the rosary.






