# Father Bill's Weekly Message

# THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

August 15<sup>th</sup> is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This year, because that date falls on a Monday, there is no obligation to attend Mass, though anyone may do so.

The Dogma of the Assumption was defined as an infallible teaching by Pope Pius XII in his apostolic constitution, "Munificentissimus Deus" ("The Most Bountiful God") on November 1, 1950. He wrote, "we pronounce, declare, and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma: that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory." (#44)


This dogma teaches that the Blessed Mother was "taken up" (assumed) into eternal life following her death without her body undergoing any decay. In the document, Pope Pius quotes St. John Damascene, who wrote, "It was fitting that she, who kept her virginity intact in childbirth, should keep her own body free from all corruption even after death. It was fitting that God's Mother should possess what belongs to her Son." (#21)

Mary's tomb, like that of her Son and Savior Jesus Christ, is empty. Her glorified body dwells in Heaven with her immortal soul. Because God shielded her from sin from the first moment of her life in the Immaculate Conception, she was prepared body and soul to enter Heaven when she died. There are saints whose bodies have undergone no corruption after their death (St. Clare of Assisi), but their bodies are still on earth. Mary's immortal body and soul are reigning with her Son in Heaven.

What has already happened for Mary, the joining of her soul to a glorified body, we hope will happen to us at the resurrection at the end of time. As we profess in the Nicene Creed: "We believe in the resurrection of the body and life everlasting." The Assumption is the celebration of Mary's "birth into Heaven."




