

Father Bill's Weekly Message

MOTHER AND TEACHER

In 1961, Pope St. John XXIII wrote an encyclical about the Church entitled, "Mater et Magistra", which in English translates as "Mother and Teacher". It revealed a different understanding of the nature of the Church from what many people believe.

The New Testament uses an image of the Church as a mother because, through the Church, new "brothers and sisters" of Jesus Christ are "born" at the font of Baptism. God is the Father of these new offspring, but the Church is the instrument God uses to bring spiritual life to His children.

In the sacramental rites, the Church is sometimes referred to as "she" or "her". This implies the image of the Church as our mother. The Church gives "birth" to new Christians through the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation and feeds her children through the Eucharist. She reconciles her children to the Father through the sacrament of Reconciliation.

Some Catholics speak about the Church as a human institution. They reveal this belief when they speak of the Church's teachings as "man-made" rules or laws. Most people who use this terminology seek to justify their rejection of that teaching as not rejecting God. They believe that they determine what comes from God and what comes from "man." In other words, these individuals believe they are the Church.

Archbishop Thomas Toolen, former bishop of Mobile-Birmingham, wrote, "The Church must be of divine institution. If it was a human institution, it would have destroyed itself long ago through the foolishness of its members."

Individual members of the Church, both clergy and laity, need correction. But Jesus promised that "the gates of hell" would not prevail against the Church. The Church is more than the sum of its parts. The "more" is the Triune God. Because human beings populate the Church, it is imperfect. But the Church is still our "mother" and should be treated with respect.


Senior Sunday and End of the Year RE Reception
