This week I authorized the transfer of \$20,134 from our Parish Unrestricted Diocesan Reserves to Catholic Charities and Communities. With that contribution, we reached the goal set by the Diocese for our parish of \$60,000.00.

I did this so that the Centers of Concern would not have to turn away hungry people who need food.

I did this so that women in crisis pregnancies would not be turned away from Catholic Family Services.

I did this so college students would be able to find a Catholic presence at the universities and colleges in our diocese.

I did this so that the religious education and youth ministries of our parish would have support from the Diocese.

I did this so that no young man discerning a call to the priesthood for our diocese would be turned away because of the inability to pay for his seminary education.

I did this so that the Catholic Church in North Alabama could fulfill its mission of reaching out as an instrument of Christ's love for those most in need of it.

I have no idea why we as a parish decreased our giving to Catholic Charities and Communities this year compared to last year. But I believe the poor, pregnant women, college students, children, and seminarians do not need to be punished because of it.


