Father Bill's Weekly Message

MISSION COOPERATIVE APPEAL

As Deacon Serge informed us in his recent homily, Mass attendance is below 40% in the United States and below 10% in Europe. Part of the reason is because of the secularization of those societies and part of the reason is that the birth rate has fallen below "replacement rate." There are fewer children to motivate their parents to participate in a parish.

However, the opposite is true in the Southern Hemisphere. In South America, Africa, and Asia the Catholic population is growing. (As are the populations of other Christian denominations.) The future of the Church seems to be in the Southern Hemisphere.

The dioceses being supported by this year's Mission Cooperative Appeal come mostly from the Southern Hemisphere. There are two dioceses from Central America, two from Africa, and two from Asia. The reason for that is that these dioceses are in impoverished areas where the Catholic population is large and/or growing.

The Catholics in these countries do not have the income to support the needs of the Church. In the United States we have the income and the opportunity to help the Church in these dioceses. These mission dioceses will benefit greatly from this collection.

The Catholic Church is missionary in nature. Our purpose is to bring the gospel of Jesus Christ to everyone. As St Francis of Assisi wrote, sometimes we use words. We have an opportunity to further the gospel of Jesus Christ by supporting this collection. In that way we are partnering with the Catholic Church in these six dioceses. We are doing what we can to further the gospel.
