Father Bill's Weekly Message

MATTHEW BRAZZOLOTTO

This weekend, Matthew Charles Joseph Brazzolotto, the son of Deacon Serge and Sarah Brazzolotto, will make his first vows in the Society of Jesus (the Jesuits). Now his official title will be Matthew Brazzolotto, SJ.

The Society of Jesus was founded by St. Ignatius of Loyola (Feast Day July 31st) in the Sixteenth century. Before his conversion, Ignatius was a soldier. He brought military discipline into the Jesuits. In addition to taking vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience, Jesuits take a fourth vow to go wherever the Pope sends them for the benefit of the Church's mission. Even the head of the Jesuits is called "the Superior General."

Matthew will become a Jesuit Scholastic. He will begin graduate-level studies in philosophy at St. Louis University, while living with the Jesuit community there. The Jesuits do not have a set number of years before a member takes perpetual vows. Matthew may be sent to serve anywhere in the world to do whatever the superiors of the Jesuits believe would best serve the order and the Church's mission. He is entering a wider world!

Matthew has one sister, Valerie, a brother-in-law, Colby, a niece Vivienne, and a nephew Oliver. Besides his biological family, Matthew grew up at Our Lady of the Lake, so his parish family shares in this event of great joy, giving thanks to God. Along with all the members of the Society of Jesus in the United States' Southern and Central Province, we pray for Matthew and his fellow former-novices, as they make their first vows. May their lives embody the Jesuit motto, "For the Greater Glory of God".

Pro Life Corner






