Father Bill's Weekly Message

DAY OF PENANCE FOR PROTECTION OF THE UNBORN

On January 22nd in the United States all Catholics will observe a day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion. (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops)

Prayer: Though the Supreme Court decision *Roe vs Wade* has been nullified, it is still left up to individual states whether they will legally permit abortions at any stage of pregnancy. Pray for the defense of all life, from conception until natural death. Daily Mass will be at 9:00 a.m. in the church. Pray the rosary or some other prayer that you prefer. Spend time praying that God will change minds and hearts about the value of human life.

Penance: An act of penance can be doing something or abstaining from doing something. Make a sacrifice that day and unite it to the sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the cross. Whatever you normally give up for Lent, give that up for one day. Give some time or treasure to benefit another person, especially the poor, the sick, or someone suffering from some weakness. Be merciful as God is merciful.

Maybe society won't change because of one day, but the people participating in prayer and penance on January 22nd might change. That will make a difference in the United States and in the World.


