Father Bill's Weekly Message

COMMUNION

The final part of the Liturgy of the Eucharist is called, "The Communion Rite." It consists of The Lord's Prayer, the Sign of Peace, the Fraction, Communion, and the Prayer After Communion.

The bread and wine are transubstantiated into the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of the Risen Lord Jesus Christ so that those worshipping Him may receive Him physically in Communion.

St. Justin, in his <u>Apology</u> (A.D. 145), wrote, "We call this food *Eucharist*, and no one may take part in it unless he believes that what we teach is true, has received baptism for the forgiveness of sins and new birth, and lives in keeping with what Christ taught."

In the Catechism of the Catholic Church, we read, "To prepare for worthy reception of this sacrament, the faithful should observe the fast required in their Church. Bodily demeanor (gestures, clothing) ought to convey the respect, solemnity, and joy of this moment when Christ becomes our guest." (CCC #1387)

"Since Christ is sacramentally present under each of the species, communion under the species of bread alone (or wine alone) makes it possible to receive all the fruit of Eucharistic grace. But "the sign of communion is more complete when given under both kinds, since in that form the sign of the Eucharistic meal appears more clearly."" (CCC #1390)

The person presenting themselves for communion should wait until the minister holds up the consecrated host or the chalice with the consecrated wine and says, "The Body of Christ" or "The Blood of Christ". Then the person should say, "Amen", that is, "Yes" or "I believe", and then make a profound bow (at the waist) before receiving communion. In the United States, a communicant may receive the host in the palm of the hand or directly on the tongue. The chalice is always handed by the minister to the communicant, who takes a sip of the Precious Blood and then hands the chalice back to the minister.


