Finance Committee: Steven Reese reported the Total Contributions for the current year are greater than budget and greater than prior year due to timing of interest on reserves (+\$7K). Operating Expenses are less than budget for the current year and less than prior year expenses. Operating Cash Flow is positive for both the current year and compared to prior year.

Knights of Columbus: James sent a report. Men's prayer service held August, 17 was a success. The BBQ sale for Labor Day Weekend will be from Thursday August 29 through Saturday August 31. KOC will be cooking hamburgers and hot dogs for the upcoming parish picnic on Sunday September 15th.

Maintenance Committee: Rodney Martin provided a report. Fairly routine month. Nothing major to report.

Latino Committee: Continue to move Our Lady of Guadalupe statue the second Saturday of every month. Each time dinner is served and the rosary is prayed. Father noted that more people are participating in the Pilgrim Virgen each month. The Anglo community is encouraged to participate.
