The meeting was opened with prayer by Matt. Jennifer called the meeting to order. The minutes from the August meeting were then approved as presented.

Committee Reports

Building Committee: The committee is not meeting currently. At this time the building project is on hold until the economy recovers from COVID-19.

Finance Committee: They will meet September 16th.

Knights of Columbus: A report was provided. The Labor Day Weekend BBQ Fundraiser was a success. More than \$7,000 in profit, plus \$1,200 were raised for the hurricane relief. Prayer service is schedule for September 19th at 9 am. Everyone is welcome.

Maintenance Committee: Report was provided. Jay Benson, Matt Allor, Bob Nicholas and Bob Hand are helping with maintenance after Rodney retired. All damaged caused by lightening has been repaired or replaced. The total cost to the parish was \$5,480.00. The deductible to the Diocese is \$1,750. The rest should be reimbursed to Our Lady of the Lake Parish. The final bill for the repairs on the building was \$26,000.00. Insurance paid \$3,300.00. Our deductible is \$1,750.00. The Diocese should reimburse us \$20,500.00. The request for the reimbursement has been sent.

Religious Education: A report was provided. Classes will start this Sunday. Senior Youth group will meet in the afternoon. Social distancing is being implemented in the classroom. First Holy

Communion was Sunday September 13th during a private mass. Approximately 25-30 people attended the mass.

Latino Committee: The group met over Zoom to pray the rosary. The statue of Our Lady of Guadalupe will be at Maria's house this month. The meetings will be held over Zoom the second Saturday of each month at 7:30 pm. Everyone is welcome. To get the link please contact Cristy McKenney.

Pastor's Report: The annual Diocesan Catholic Charities drive will be the weekend of September 26-27. Our goal is the same as last year (\$51,000.00). We did not meet last year's goal. A parishioner made a donation for the purchase of a bell and tower to go on the property. A church sign will be affixed to the tower to replace our current sign. There is a set of drawings from Goodgame Construction. The bell is 33 ½ inches in diameter and will be rung electronically rather than by hand.
