The meeting was opened with prayer by Debbie Gossett. Jeff Reach called the meeting to order. October's meeting minutes were read. A few changes were brought up: Cristy Mckinney's name was spelled incorrectly, the K of C prayer service is the 11th not the 18th of December, Finance Council met Oct 18th, and Synod was spelled incorrectly. The changes were made to the minutes and then approved.

Building Committee - Fr. Bill

-Bell Tower-Work has begun. Construction is scheduled to take 8 weeks depending on the weather.

-Columbarium-The Committee met Nov 11th. The Diocese now has a standardized contract for purchasing the rights to use the niches in a columbarium. The CFO of the Diocese has given permission to use money from our Building Fund Account with the Diocese to assist with financing the construction. The weekend of Jan 8th & 9th Doug Ross will make a presentation at each Mass about the Columbarium and how people can purchase space. The next weekend, Jan 15th &16th we will begin selling rights to use the niches. After the first of the year, we will have a Building Committee meeting with the architect and contractor to get a formal bid on the work. We will need Diocesan approval to begin construction. We should break ground in 2022.

Finance Council- Fr. Bill

-Cash & Reserve- As of Oct 31st we have \$8,595.26 in our checking account and in our Diocesan account we have \$613,595.95 which is an interest barring account. Restricted Funds we have Misc. Funds=\$78,765.20 and this is for Social Concerns for Christmas giving program, utilities assistance, and other similar type programs. OLL Building Fund is an account we have at Metro Bank-\$\$122,205.36. This money was not moved to our Diocesan account because they thought we would already be under construction by now for the Bell Tower. Diocesan Building Funds-\$759,269.26-this is the monthly building fund collections and in Nov we got a contribution from the estate of Betty and Yolie for \$535,000.00 so after this it should put us at 1.3 million in this account.

-Summary of Income & Expense- This is for July thru October 2021-\$20,261.66 is from the Payroll Protection Plan which was a grant so it does not have to be paid back. This is not income. These moneys were to help with Covid related payroll expenses. Our income is above what we projected it to be mostly because of what we have in Social Concerns. Expenses are below what we budgeted for. Cash flow is positive.

Children will carry roses to present to her.
