## Building Committee-Fr. Bill

- -We finally received the invoice from Hale Construction for the Bell Tower. The total cost billed was approximately \$110,000.00 for all their work. The invoice was paid this month.
- -A presentation for the Columbarium project was made to the College of Consultors on Sept. 15, 2022. They recommended to the bishop for us to proceed with construction.

- -Total quoted cost for Columbarium is \$290,384.00 The funds available in the Columbarium Fund is \$87,813.00. The balance will come from the Parish Building Fund in the Diocesan Deposit and Loan. That current balance is \$1,418,658.93. If people purchase the rights to use the niches during construction, 90% of those payments will go into the Columbarium Fund. (10% goes into a Perpetual Care Account)
- -A contract will be drawn up by the Architect. It will be sent to the Diocesan Attorney for review. Then it will be sent to the bishop's delegate for signature. Once it is signed, construction can begin. Depending on the weather, construction could take six months to complete. Goodgame is ready to start anytime now.
